Summary of Responsibilities	The Fort Bend Museum announces the opening for a six-month internship in spring 2018, roughly running from January to early July. The successful intern candidate will have the opportunity to assist with projects including, but not limited to, planning and presentation of educational programming, collections care, exhibition development, interpretation research and facilitation, visitor services, and special event coordination over the course of the internship. Approximately 40 hours per week, Tuesday through Saturday.
Required Qualifications	Will be a graduate or undergraduate candidate in museum studies, public history, or history from an accredited institution, with a focus/interest in museum exhibition, collections management, or museum education. Experience working in museums preferred.
Compensation	Housing will be provided at the Museum's sister organization, the George Ranch Historical Park. A \$100/wk stipend is also available. The Fort Bend Museum's Chief Curator will work with candidate to establish course credit and meet appropriate requirements. Candidate must have a car while completing the internship.
